A working definition of clinical forensic medicine has been suggested as: "clinical forensic medicine includes all medical (healthcare) fields which may relate to legal, judicial, and police systems" (Payne-James, 1994). In part this increased relevance relates to much wider awareness of human rights abuses and civil liberties which in turn have directed much attention to the conditions of detention of prisoners, and to the application of justice to both victim and suspect.
