In your text, cite according to the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association, but in your references section, use "The Bluebook: A Uniform System of Citation." The Federal Acquisition Regulation is part of the code of federal regulations and is cited as such.

How to Cite the Federal Acquisition Regulation in APA ...

Write the name of the federal regulation you want to cite in your APA-style reference list followed by a comma. For example, write "FDA Prescription Drug Advisory Rule." Write the volume number of the Code of Federal Regulations in which the rule you are citing is entered, followed by the abbreviation "C.F.R." which stands for "Code of Federal Regulations."

In-text citation doesn't vary depending on source type, unless the author is unknown. Reference list citations are highly variable depending on the source. How to Cite a Book (Title, not chapter) in APA Format. Book referencing is the most basic style; it matches the template above, minus the URL section.

Many series of documents are made available for public viewing and may be used for citing military standards, and federal and military specifications. The method of citation for these military specifications is specified by Construction Engineering Research Laboratory (CERL), which focuses on research activities and provides coordination with communities in regard to military operations.

Finish the citation by typing the word "Retrieved" followed by the date, then type the word "from" and provide the direct URL for the paper, without a period at the end.
